Rules: SSA & CMP Competition rules will apply.

Eligibility: Participants will sign a CMP eligibility affidavit and liability agreement along with a SSA hold harmless agreement.

Fees: Solon Sportsmen Association Members \$5, Nonmembers \$15 per Adult, Juniors (NRA rule 2.3) are \$5

Rifles Allowed: As-Issued US M1 Carbine. A limited number of M1 Carbines will be available to borrow, please RSVP if a rifle is needed. Other rifles will be permitted; however, they will be recorded as out-of-competition and not eligible for achievement pins.

Ammunition: CMP Ammo will be available for purchase, \$20 for 50 rounds. Otherwise, competitors must supply their own ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Sights: Metallic Sights Only

Awards: Gold, Silver or Bronze Achievement Pins per

current CMP cut scores for M1 Carbine.

Course of Fire: The course of fire for the M1 Carbine Match is the M1 Carbine Match Course of Fire (Table 9).

Stage 1: Slow Fire Sighters – 10 sighters max in a time limit of 10 minutes.

Stage 2: Slow Fire prone –10 shots for record in a time limit of 5 minutes.

May load from the magazine, 5 rounds per mag.

Stage 3: Rapid fire – standing to prone - 10 shots for record in a time limit of 60 seconds.

Must make 1 magazine change. 5 rounds per mag

Stage 4: Rapid fire – standing to sitting or kneeling - 10 shots for record in a time limit of 60 seconds.

Must make 1 magazine change. 5 rounds per mag

Stage 5: Slow fire standing – 10 shots for record in a time limit of 10 minutes.

May load from the magazine, 5 rounds per mag.

Note 1 – In the offhand stage, the Carbine should normally be cradled in the arms, safety on with the muzzle directed downrange towards the targets.

Note 2 – Sighting shots may be taken from the sitting or prone position. A rest or support may be used for sighters but not in any other position.
