NRA Sanctioned Matches: Competitors scores and NRA registration fees are sent to NRA competitions at year's end and count toward your NRA HP or F-Class classification.

Dates: Saturday May 18th Saturday June 29th

Saturday July 20th Saturday Aug 17th Saturday Oct 5th

Location: SSA grounds, 5426 Footville-Richmond

Directions: I-90 to SR11 exit 228.

South on SR11 to SR 307. East on 307 to SR193. North on SR193 to Footville-Richmond Rd. East approx.. 4 miles on Footville-Richmond Rd. to

club gate, on the South side of the road.

Time to arrive: Front gate will open from 7:30 AM until 8:15 AM for sign in and squadding.

Sqadding: Sign in and squadding is at the building just inside the front gate between 7:30 and 8:15 AM with final adjustments made on the 600 yard line. All competitors must present themselves when their relay is called, and report for his/her duty in the pits before they seal to be scored in this event.

Time of firing: The pits should seal at 8:30 AM and firing begins thereafter from the 600 yard line.

Entries at the match: Until 8:15 AM

Entries by mail: None.

Rules: Current SSA & NRA competition rules apply.

Eligibility: SSA & Non SSA members are welcome. All entrants of this match should be experienced marksmen. Competitors must sign an annual liability release agreement. All rifles shall have at least a known 200 yard zero to apply 600 yard "come ups."

Fees: \$20 for non members. \$5 for SSA members. Juniors (NRA rule 2.3) are \$5

Rifles Allowed: Service, Match or F-class rifles. NRA rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2. Per NRA rule 3.16.1 "The use of compensators or muzzle brakes is prohibited."

Ammunition: .35 cal & below. Competitors must provide their own ammunition. No incendiary or tracer ammo is permitted.

Sights: Metallic sights, telescopic sights, any sights per NRA rule 3.7a, b, c.

Target: MR-1 or MR-1FC target.

Sighting shots: Five sighting shots are allowed prior to each match.

Pit changes: As required.

Course of fire:

Match 1 Any Rifle/Any Sight - 5 sighting shots and 20 shots for record

Match 2 Any Rifle/Any Sight – 5 sighting shots and 20 shots for record.

Match 3 Any Rifle/Iron Sights – 5 sighting shots and 20 shots for record.

Match 4 The match winner: Aggregate of matches 1-3

The above match program is a "standard" NRA MR/LR match program. Competitors may deviate from this program providing they comply with current NRA high power rules.

Note - If your rifle does not have a known zero, you must notify the line officer.
